School and youth event packages are available for groups of 12 or more between the ages of 5-18. Sales tax not included. Available Monday-Friday 9am-4pm. Reservations require a 50% deposit at time of booking or purchase order. Individual forms of payment not allowed.

# BEFORE YOUR VISIT

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- Submit Purchase Order or 50% deposit to secure reservation
- Confirm final catering & activity headcount
  - due 10 days prior
- Assign chaperones
  - recommended ratio: 1 adult per 15-20 students
- Review student behavior expectations prior to arrival (bowling in socks)
- Cash must be put onto game cards
- Designate one on-site lead contact
- Confirm student age range
- Prepare single form of payment
  - individual payments not accepted

# DURING YOUR VISIT:

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- Ensure students are supervised at all times
- Announcements can be made throughout building or in sections at a time
- Position chaperones throughout bowling, arcade, and activity areas
- Follow assigned rotation schedule (if applicable)
- Report any concerns to staff immediately

# FIELD TRIP FAQ

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## *Frequently Asked Questions for Teachers & Administrators*

### **1. Is a deposit required to book?**

Yes. A 50% deposit or approved Purchase Order is required to secure your reservation. Your date will be marked tentative until one of these is received.

### **2. When is final payment due?**

Final payment may be:

- Collected the day of your visit, or
- Submitted by mailed payment after the event

Because payment is collected based on your confirmed final headcount, refunds are not issued after numbers have been locked in.

### **3. When are final headcounts due?**

Final catering and activity headcounts are due 10 days prior to your visit.

We understand that things happen! Activity headcount may be adjusted the day of your visit for up to 10 students.

### **4. Can students pay individually?**

No. Individual payments are not accepted.

All payments must be submitted in one form by the school.

### **5. What is the recommended chaperone ratio?**

We recommend 1 adult per 15-20 students.

Chaperones should be actively supervising and positioned throughout activity areas.

### **6. What if our group is very large?**

Groups over 150 students may be divided into two groups.

One group will begin bowling while the other begins in the arcade or activity area. Groups will rotate at the 1.5-hour mark.

### **7. Will other schools be there during our visit?**

Possibly. Multiple schools may attend during similar timeframes.

We do our best to offset activity locations to minimize overlap and congestion.

### **8. Can we include lunch?**

Yes! Pizza and lemonade can be added to your package.

We recommend aligning lunch timing with your students' regular school schedule.

### **9. What time should we arrive?**

Please arrive at your scheduled start time to ensure your group receives the full experience.

Buses should park parallel with the building for easy loading and unloading.

### **10. What happens if our numbers change?**

We allow day-of adjustments for up to 10 students.

For larger changes, please contact our sales team as soon as possible.

### **11. What ages are eligible for field trip packages?**

Kintergarden through twelfth grade

# FACILITY & OPERATIONAL POLICIES

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## Headcount Confirmation & Final Payment Policy

Final catering and activity headcounts must be submitted no later than 10 calendar days prior to the scheduled event date.

Once submitted, the confirmed headcount will serve as the basis for final billing. Attendance adjustments of up to 10 students may be accommodated on the day of the event.

Final payment will be calculated using the confirmed headcount and may be:

- Remitted on the day of the event, or
- Submitted via mailed payment following the event, in accordance with district payment procedures.

As staffing, food preparation, and facility allocations are determined based on the confirmed attendance, refunds will not be issued once headcounts have been finalized.

## Facility & Operational Policies

### Payment Methods Onsite

- Cash is not accepted at registers throughout the facility.
- Cash may be loaded onto game cards for use within the arcade and applicable attractions. All group payments must be submitted in a single form by the school or organizing entity.


### Food & Beverage Service

- For groups of 50 or more guests, a limited café menu may be in effect to ensure timely service and operational efficiency.
- The café will reopen for general ordering after designated group lunch times.
- Sack lunches are not permitted. Students with documented food allergies may bring individual meals as needed. Advance notification of severe allergies is requested.

### Capacity & Scheduling

- Grand Station can accommodate up to 700 guests. During peak field trip windows, multiple schools may be scheduled concurrently. Activity rotations and staggered use of spaces may be implemented to ensure an organized experience for all groups.

- Follow arrows for bus parking


## Bus Parking:
